The Inspire Wisconsin online platform uses company profiles to match the talent needs of companies with students' career aspirations.

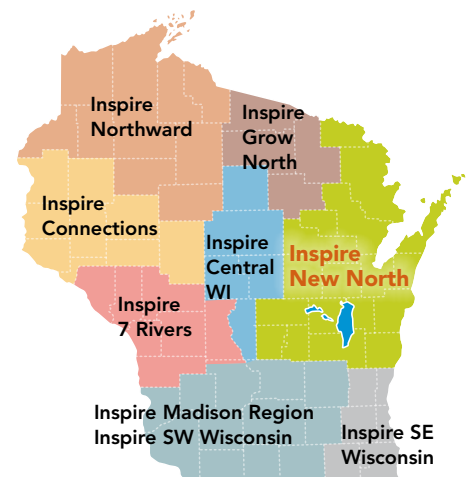
