State of Wisconsin's economy is strong and positioned for more growth


Today we'll cover

- Revenue collections have been and continue to be some of the strongest we've seen




### Other tax relief in Wisconsin Act 58

- Ongoing tax relief of \$1B annually
- 2/3<sup>rd</sup> funding for education means property tax relief
- \$72M over the biennium in Tech College property tax relief
- Child and dependent care tax credit claimers will be able to claim 50% of the federal credit for WI purposes
- Exempts all "active-duty" income
