**Multicultural Coalition, Inc. hosts upcoming  
vaccination events in Oshkosh and Neenah**

*Events give families a chance to receive booster shots and  
children get free teddy bears*

**FOX VALLEY, Wis. (June 21, 2022)** – On Wednesday, June 22 from 3:30 – 6:30 p.m., the Multicultural Coalition, Inc. (MCI) will hold a free COVID-19 vaccination event at [St. Paul's United Church of Christ](#), located at 1250 Leonard Point Road in Oshkosh ([map](#)). A follow-up vaccination event will be held at this same location from 3:30-6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, July 13.

MCI will host another vaccination event on Tuesday, June 28 from 11 a.m. – 2 p.m. at the [Neenah Public Library](#), located at 240 E. Wisconsin Ave. in Neenah ([map](#)). A secondary clinic will be held at this same location on Tuesday, July 19 from 11 a.m. – 2 p.m.

“We know the library is a spot where many families and children gather during the summer months,” explained Ernesto Gonzalez, MCI board member and president of Casa Hispana Inc. “We have seen a lot of success by bringing these vaccination clinics to the people, especially at the local libraries, and we’re excited to be back again to offer these resources.”

Both clinics will offer the Pfizer vaccine for anyone ages five and older; those under 18-years-old must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Adults can receive their choice of either the Pfizer, Moderna or Johnson & Johnson vaccines. First, second and/or booster shots will be provided. ID and health insurance are not required.

These community-led events feature:

- Interpreters for those who speak Hmong and/or Spanish
- Snacks
- Free books for kids
- Diapers and personal hygiene products for those who need them

The vaccination clinic at St. Paul's United Church of Christ will be hosted by multiple community partners including Multicultural Coalition, Inc., Red Shoes Inc., Partnership Community Health Center, N.E.W. Hmong Professionals, Pointters Community Initiatives, RISE, United Way Fox Cities, People of Progression, CAP Services, AMI, Casa Hispana Inc., ESTHER, Ecumenical Catholic Community of Oshkosh (Emmaus), St. Paul's United Church of Christ, Oshkosh Area Community Pantry and Winnebago Area Literacy Council.

The vaccination clinic at the Neenah Public Library will be hosted by multiple community partners including Multicultural Coalition, Inc., Red Shoes Inc., Partnership Community Health Center, N.E.W. Hmong Professionals, Casa Hispana Inc., United Way Fox Cities, CAP Services, RISE, Valley Transit, Neenah Public Library, Harbor House, People of Progression, AMI, LEAVEN, Winnebago Area Literacy Council, Piña Limón, Youth Go, Building for Kids and Heckrodt Wetland Reserve and Bergstrom-Mahler Museum.
